Dear Jairus,

As per your request, I've compiled information about WFTDA member leagues in your fifteen targeted markets.

The WFTDA can coordinate access to derby leagues, derby events, and on-line derby messaging across the entire range of member markets. Each WFTDA league manages its own sponsorship, web, and bout programming, and the WFTDA is working with all of them to develop a comprehensive promotional platform so that supporters can tap into derby's nationally thriving underground community.

Sister WFTDA leagues across the country can simultaneously promote Sony artists and projects, blanketing the growing national derby fan and skater base across multiple markets with a variety of local activation techniques, such as:

- Banners, program ads on-site
- CD/DVD giveaways on-site (raffle prizes, VIP hospitality giveaways)
- Heavy rotation in bout music playlists
- Pre-bout co-promotion of branded derby events
- On-line messaging using derby fan subscription lists and web ads
- Incorporation of 'featured Sony artist' music widget on league web sites
- Fan participation contests (air guitar, name-that-tune, etc.)
- Tying album release parties into skating events
- Establishment of streaming bout action portals for bouts and tournaments
- etc.

Without further ado, here is an overview of leagues ready to bring on Sony as a promotional partner in your target markets:

Other major events on the 2010 derby calendar include:

- The WFTDA's tournaments.

Four regional tournaments in September and October (in White Plains, Green Bay, Sacramento, and Lincoln) lead up to the **2010 Nationals in Chicago**, **the "Uproar by the Lakeshore"** (November 12-14, at UIC Pavillion).

The WFTDA directly controls sponsorship inventory at all five tournament events.

Other major roller derby events are coming up in 2010. Local tournament hosts control sponsorship inventory, but the WFTDA can facilitate and coordinate access.

- "Sunshine Skate Tournament" Feb 14 in Tampa the annual Florida state championship
- "Governor's Cup Tournament" Feb 20-21 in Austin the annual Texas state championship
- "Wild West Showdown" a large exhibition Feb 26-28 in Bremerton,
 Washington (near Seattle), hosted by the WFTDA's Slaughter County Roller Vixens
- the Dallas Derby Devils are planning an area tournament for the weekend of March 5th.
- "Dust Bowl Invitational" March 27-28 in Bakersfield, California a major exhibition of 20+ western roller derby teams
- "Dust Devil 2010" April 17-18 a multi-team exhibition in Tucson, AZ
- "Spring Roll Tournament" May 8th a multi-team exhibition Fort Wayne, Indiana
- "Midwest BrewHaHa" May 22-23. Twenty-four high-profile bouts in Milwaukee, hosted by the BrewCity Bruisers at the Milwaukee County Sports Complex.
- "East Coast Extravaganza," an annual two-day festival featuring twenty WFTDA All-Star bouts, back-to-back-to-back. The fourth edition will be June 26-27, 2010. This event, annually hosted by the Philadelphia Rollergirls, historically draws 2500 participants and spectators.
- "Rollercon 2010," the massive yearly convention of 1000+ skaters, refs, and volunteers at the Tropicana Resort & Casino, Las Vegas, July 28 August 1.

The WFTDA's promotional platform can help partners tap in to a growing community of sports fans who look off the beaten path for memorable entertainment experiences. The Association is completing a more rigorous demographic profile of our fans and skaters across the country, which I'll be happy to share on completion.

I hope this paints the picture you were looking for with respect to how a band or label can access the derby fan base in a multi-citi promotion. I'm sure we'll be in touch!

Additional Facts and Figures About the Women's Flat Track Derby Association

There are currently 78 WFTDA leagues, each with 25-100 skaters ready to be ambassadors for their partners. **WFTDA league skaters = 4,800.**

There are 28 additional "Apprentice Leagues" in the pipeline to join the WFTDA, including the WFTDA's first European affiliate, the London Rollergirls.

Each league stages 6-10 local bouts a year.

Each bout attracts 500-4,000 fans (national average: 950)

National WFTDA ticket buyers = appx 480,000 per year
